### *NCFLA Welcomes New Members*

**Full individual membership** is open to owners of 5 or more acres of woodland in Cameron, Elk, McKean, or Potter counties. Full membership entitles member to one vote in association business. Properties of multiple blocks or held by more than one owner, such as clubs, corporations, partnerships, estates, etc., will have one vote.

**Family membership**, also open to owners of 5 or more acres of woodland in NCFLA counties, entitles immediate family members for a given property 2 votes in association business.

**Associate membership** (non-voting) is open to all others interested in proper forest management who do not own land, or may own land in other counties.

**Student membership** (non-voting) is open to full-time students who reside in, or attend school in the region who are interested in proper forest management.

The NCFLA membership year runs from Jan. 1 to Dec. 31. Dues are annual.

## Why Join NCFLA?

The Association was formed in 1998 for private forest landowners and others who are interested in learning more about sustainable forest management, wildlife habitat improvement, and related stewardship practices. The organization provides opportunities to meet other forest landowners who share similar experiences in managing their properties.
